The Alabama Geological Society invites you to attend a core description workshop. Participants will examine and describe two cores, in order to better understand what can be seen in cores but might be missed from geophysical well logs. Cores from the coal-bearing Pennsylvanian Pottsville Formation and the Upper Cretaceous Selma and Tuscaloosa groups will provide good primary sedimentary structures as well as diagenetic and tectonic features for examination. Exercises will include stratigraphic and sedimentological interpretations of core and construction of stratigraphic columns.
